Who can take this course?

The Vascular Sonography Workshop is designed for Sonographers, Radiologists, Residents and Physicians who are interested in refreshing their Doppler skills or expanding their scope of practice in Vascular technology. All participants must be ARDMS or CARDUP registered or registry eligible.

What will I gain from taking this course?

- Acquire a deeper understanding of cerebrovascular, peripheral and abdominal arterial and venous anatomy and pathophysiology.
- Gain knowledge of vascular physics and instrumentation.
- Discuss appropriate techniques and protocols for performing vascular duplex exams.
- Learn to differentiate normal from abnormal color Doppler images and spectral tracings.
- Practice providing a technical impression based on direct and indirect results. Practice on live patient models.
